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Green Blocking Your Time Using Todd Duncan's Law of the Broom and Law of the Hourglass

Law of the Hour Glass

Manage your moves, not your time.

Law of the Broom

To build your business UP, first clean it up.

Green Blocking your calendar + clients or projects for profit. Higher \$\$ + less stress.

The Green Time blocking principles:

- Time is not manageable.
- What you can manage are your actions, choices and decisions.
- How you plan your time can have a positive result on trust and relationship building.
- You make more money spend less time and have less stress doing what you are naturally good at.

Four-Step Client Management Process

Level One - Profit low, client | project (or both) = high maintenance.

Ultimately: graduate this client | project (Literally out or to Level Three at least).

Level Two - High Profit, High Maintenance client | project. (Re-edu. & invite to Level Three or Four.)

Level Three - Lower Profit, Low Maintenance client | project + new learning + enjoyment for you.

Level Four - High Profit, Low Maintenance, strong relationship, ongoing new learning for you.

May be a long-time client or project you are mainly co-journeying or providing oversight with at their specific request.

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Green Time Leveraging involves putting your best foot forward with clients | projects at Level Three and Level Four, and re-training and inviting your Level One and Two clients | project-principles to join you at Level Three or graduate on out of your business - gracefully.

Green Time Blocking Is:

- scheduling your priorities rather than prioritizing your schedule
- predefining your green activities necessary for your business to excel
- incorporating green "blocks" of time daily to create predictability and certainty
- an efficient, effective way for clients and support team to be apprised of your activities without your continuously updating emails or return calls
- initially challenging but ultimately cost-effective and profit-contributing

The Green Time Blocking Is NOT:

- trying not to waste time
- a rigid declaration
- a "to do" list
- a quick fix
